Hello Team,

I'm reaching out to expand a conversation that I had with Eric, Brian, Randy, and Anna last week. Max and Ted have made a system/content template request that we need to research and respond to them with if or how we could accommodate their ask, followed by a demo of the feature. They would like the canvas to be broken into three element per bay: Glass, Small I-Beams (Horizontal and Vertical), and Large I-Beams (Vertical). See reference attached. I recognize we are not warping the Large I-Beam now and will be addressing that challenge in a different thread. For this group I would like to focus on how we can create a content or Pandora template that will provide clean results (hard edge masks + iffy alignment can look terrible, pointing out the flaws in the system and distracting from the intended effect), allows for live video from our Matrix, and is not too labor some to maintain long term for the content or PB teams.

.....and go.....no wait.

Demo timeframe: To prepare for the separation of window and beam content we need auto calibration completed, a content template or PB template created, content generated, and at least a few days of trial and error before showing the client. What we would put in front of Ted and Max as first test should be somewhere between 1-4 bays. With all of this in mind and to make sure the team stays focused on the mission at hand (completing our milestone to get paid and the project to continue as a whole) I'm going to suggest that the template be created no sooner the first week of September with a demonstration for Ted and Max no sooner than late-September because our Auto Calibration will not be completed until the last week of August. Discussions and planning can surely happen in advance.

Who is willing to own this action? My thought is we need one person from the PB team and one from the Content team.
